



- Swami Vivekananda made the world aware of India's spiritual wisdom that respected and accepted all traditions.
- His global vision and mission inspired India's spiritual reach world-wide.
- As the initiator of the global spiritual awareness,
 Swamiji propagated the universal vision of Dharma as India's unique gift to the world.
- He saw his global mission as the expression of the Divine Will, reassuring that India would send hundreds like him overseas to continue the Indian spiritual reach into the world.







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Swamiji declared:

"The world requires light. It is expectant! India alone has the light of the highest spiritual truth. India's gift to the word is the light spiritual. The mission given to us is to conserve, to preserve, to accumulate, as it were, into a dynamo, all spiritual energy of the race and that concentrated energy is to pour forth in a deluge on the world whenever circumstances are propitious."







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- God, according to Swamiji, was guiding the destiny of India, and he wanted the Eternal Truths of Dharma to be preached by the Indian Masters who would go out in hundreds, to the world at large, and it became a reality in the last 100 years. Swamiji said:
 - That I went to America was not my doing or your doing, but the God of India who is guiding her destiny, sent me, and will send hundreds of such to all the nations of the world. No power on earth can resist it. You must go out and preach your religion, preach it to every nation under the sun, and preach it to every people."











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- Swamiji's vision is getting unfolded world over through many individuals and institutions inspired by his universal spiritual vision.

Conceived by Sri K. Suryanarayana Rao (1924-2016), Akhil Bharatiya Seva Pramukh of Rashtriya Swayam Sevak Sangh, this project was envisioned to encompass all the countries of the world, to culminate into an all-inclusive resource on the Dharma organisations. 
