ENROLLMENT OF ORGANISATIONS

1. GENERAL CRITERIA

- Reputed & registered organisations with considerable followers, and with minimum three branches outside India (these branches may be in one country or more).

2. SCOPE OF THE DIRECTORY

- To cover organizations of the *Dharma* Traditions (the Sanatana, Jain, Buddha, Sikh, et al), including the 'Himalayan (Yogic) Tradition', and others who accept, respect and celebrate the diversity of Traditions; regard the whole world as one family; and dedicated to 'Universal Peace & Brotherhood', recognising & acknowledging the Spiritual Truth of 'Oneness of Existence' behind everyone and everything.

3. PARTICIPANTS

- **Monasteries** (Ashrams & Vedanta Centers)
- **Places of Worship** (Temples / Gurudwaras / Viharas / Derasar, et al)
- **Yoga Centers** (of various traditions originated in Bharat)
- **Academic Institutions** (of Bharatiya Traditions)
- **NGOs** (Volunteer Organizations engaged in various seva activities / Foundations / Trusts / Associations, et al).
- **Individual Mahatmas** (with their various activities)
- **Miscellaneous** (Organisations other than that of the preceding categories, if any)

4. REGISTRATION

- **FREE REGISTRATION** enables the Organizations to directly post their details in the Directory (www.disoa.org), and also update the same, from time to time, as and when necessary.
- Organisations of various categories (enumerated above, in different countries, world over) are welcome to get the **REGISTRATION FORM** duly filled out (from a responsible person of the organisation) with the required particulars, and email the same to <coordinator@disoa.org>, to enable those organisations to be enrolled in the Directory. After the registration, the organisations concerned can directly post in their respective pages in the online Directory (at www.disoa.org): History, tradition, aims and ideals (in brief); A few lines about the present leadership; Activities & Publications, if any (in brief); Public participation in the activities (in brief); Future plans, if any, & also other useful information, if any. They can also upload a few related pictures, including that of their present Head.

5. MINIMUM TARGET

- To enroll at least 1000 organisations (from as many countries as possible, world over).
